We responded to a violent party that was out of control and crews had to help S.O by sedating them so they could be transported.

Responded to a wildland fire off the Peak-to-Peak Highway. There were several delays dispatching us because Dispatch had it as a pile burn fire. Fortunately, Emmit Hoyl who is a neighbor was called direct by a passerby telling him his property was on fire. Emmit's family owns their own brush truck and was able to get some of the fire out before we got on-scene.

We responded mutual aid with Coal Creek Fire on a large shop on fire. Crews were able to bring 3000 gallons of water to help get the fire out.

We hired a new PRN Paramedic- Mike Techentin. Mike has already done 5 full days of field training, has been signed off, and has covered 2 vacant shifts already.
