NEDERLAND FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT HOT WORK PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

Plans and/or spec sheets are required on all permit submissions to Nederland Fire.

Permit applications must be submitted online and upon approval will be good for 30 days.

SUBMIT PERMIT APPLICATION



The following outlines the requirements for Hot Work:

- 1. On the day the work is to be performed, there can be NO:
 - a. Fire restrictions https://bouldercounty.gov/safety/fire/fire-restrictions/
 - b. Red Flag warnings: https://www.weather.gov/bou/fire
 - c. Wind advisories/warnings: https://forecast.weather.gov/MapClick.php?lat=39.964025&lon=-105.504352
- 2. There must be 5' of space between the hot work and ANY combustible material or structure, and the work must be done on a "hard surface" (i.e. asphalt, concrete, mineral soil).
- Means of suppression must be readily available. (i.e. bucket, hose or appropriate extinguisher for material being used: https://www.nfpa.org/news-blogs-and-articles/blogs/2023/08/01/fire-extinguisher-types)
