NEDERLAND FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT PYROTECHNICS PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

Plans and/or spec sheets are required on all permit submissions to Nederland Fire. Permit applications must be submitted online and upon approval will be good for 365 days.

Applications for pyrotechnics will permit use of fireworks or special effects which have an open flame and **must be submitted no less than 10 working days prior** to a scheduled event.

 Notification of events by a permitted performers/vendors shall be submitted to <u>permits@nederlandfire.org</u> - Notification must be submitted for each performance and include the permit number and event details.



SUBMIT PERMIT APPLICATION

The following outlines the requirements for pyrotechnics:

- 1. Submit a safety plan that includes perimeter/barricades, extinguishment, and safety procedures.
- 2. On the day the pyrotechnics are to be performed, there can be NO:
 - a. Fire restrictions https://bouldercounty.gov/safety/fire/fire-restrictions/
 - b. Red Flag warnings: https://www.weather.gov/bou/fire
 - c. Wind advisories/warnings: https://forecast.weather.gov/MapClick.php?lat=39.964025&lon=-105.504352
- 3. For aerial display fireworks:
 - a. All storage, use, and discharge of fireworks displays shall be in accordance with NFPA 1123 Code for the Outdoor Display of Fireworks.
 - b. A permit shall only be issued to a qualified and approved Pyrotechnic Operator certified by the State of Colorado. https://dfpc.colorado.gov/sections/professional-qualifications-and-training/certification/fireworks-certification
- 4. A minimum clear distance between the pyrotechnics and your audience of 35' for ground-based items and 150' for aerial items.
- 5. The display/launch area must be in a clear, open area, away from buildings, vehicles, overhead obstructions and shrubbery or other vegetation. Pyrotechnics shall not be displayed indoors under any circumstances.
